What are some of the challenges posed by social media and other new technologies?

These pose new challenges to human culture inasmuch as they are shaping personal relations and changing family and social relationships: *“Today the modern media, which are an essential part of life for young people in particular, can be both a help and a hindrance to communication in and between families. The media can be a hindrance if they become a way to avoid listening to others, to evade physical contact, to fill up every moment of silence and rest, so that we forget that ‘silence is an integral element of communication; in its absence, words rich in content cannot exist’* **(Benedict XVI, Message for the 2012 World Communications Day).**

The media can help communication when they enable people to share their stories, to stay in contact with distant friends, to thank others or to seek their forgiveness, and to open the door to new encounters.

By growing daily in our awareness of the vital importance of encountering others, we will employ technology wisely, rather than letting ourselves be dominated by it.

While Parents are the primary educators, they cannot be left to their own devices - **the Christian community is called to help them** in teaching children how to live in a media environment in a way *consonant with the dignity of the human person and service of the common good”* **(Pope Francis, Message for 2015 World Communications Day).**

We can & should use social media to **encourage respect, dialogue, and honest relationships—in other words, "true friendship"** *(Pope Benedict XVI's Message for the 43rd World Communications Day, 2009).*


